



1. The [Bookmark/Notes](#) icon launches a new window where a bookmark can be immediately created by simply entering data in the Name and Notes field.
2. The [Audio/Video Window](#) displays the video content in Windows Media (ASF) or Real Media (RM) streaming format. The Video Caption frame displays a synchronized transcript of the video.
3. The [Previous/Next Page](#) buttons advance and reverse the pages while repositioning the video to the appropriate place enabling you to quickly get to the information you want.
4. The [Collapsible Table of Contents](#) allows you to expand or collapse the Table of Contents one section at a time with a single mouse click. This feature provides you with more control over and interactivity with the presentation.
5. [Topic Highlighting](#) follows along with the video, enabling you to always know which section is being viewed. This feature provides a quick point of reference in the presentation relative to the video, thus eliminating “guess work”.
6. The [Show/Hide Transcript](#) feature will hide the transcript frame, giving you control over how you view the information.
7. The [Clickable Transcript](#) feature allows you to click on a transcript line and the video, as well as the pages in the iView, will reposition accordingly – providing you with the information that is most important. In addition, it allows you to revisit information that is important while keeping all of the media assets repositioned and synchronized.
8. [Transcript Highlighting](#) focuses on the current text tract being spoken. This feature provides you with a quick and easy point of reference in the text tract.
9. The [Search Function](#) searches the transcript for key words or phrases. This feature searches both the Transcript and any Bookmarks or Notes. This powerful search capability greatly enhances your productivity.
10. The [Status Bar](#) displays the status of the media (playing, paused, buffering, etc.) and the current time code of the media as well as the duration of the entire presentation. This feature saves time by providing an indication of how long the overall presentation is and how much has been viewed.
11. The [iView Window](#) displays the supporting materials for your presentation.
12. The [User-Controlled Full Screen Video](#) allows you to right click on a button, doubling the video size, and eliminating all other frames. This feature enables you to focus entirely on the expanded video providing a better viewing and learning experience.
13. The [Telecom Essentials Learning Center](#) provides you with a host of resources to enhance and reinforce your learning experience. Features include presentation notes, online quizzes, online glossary, discussion forums, recommended books, recommended magazines, and key sites to visit, all organized according to the modules of the course.
